

Add a Mac to Apple Business Manager or Apple School Manager with Apple Configurator

Apple Configurator for iPhone can add an eligible Mac to Apple Business Manager (ABM) or Apple School Manager (ASM), even when the Mac was not purchased through Apple or a participating reseller. After Apple records the Mac, assign it to FileWave and complete the normal Automated Device Enrollment (ADE) workflow.

Requirements

- iPhone running iOS 16 or later, with Apple Configurator installed and connected to the internet
- The Mac is not currently assigned to another organization's Apple Business Manager or Apple School Manager account
- The macOS device to enroll is either Apple silicon or has an Apple T2 Security Chip and is running macOS 12.0.1+
- The macOS device to enroll is erased and not yet set up
- A Managed Apple Account with permission to add devices and manage device-management-service assignments in ABM or ASM

 If the Mac is already in use, back up all required data before erasing all content and settings. Apple Configurator must capture the Mac at the Select Your Country or Region pane in Setup Assistant.

 Apple gives users a 30-day provisional period in which a manually added device can be released from ABM or ASM, supervision, and the assigned device management service. The period begins after the device is successfully assigned and enrolled.

Directions

1. Launch Apple Configurator on the iPhone and sign in with the required Managed Apple Account
2. Turn on the macOS device to enroll and connect to the network. Consider connecting the power adaptor to prevent the device from sleeping
3. Place the iPhone next to the Mac, ready to scan the upcoming image
