

Having DB folder on a different Volume(symblink) slows the admin performance

Issue : If you have a symlink to /fwxserver folder (Data Folder and DB folder are on network volume i.e NAS) it is possible that you experience performance issue's with the FileWave Central.

Resolution: We strongly recommend that you that if you are on version 4.0 & above only create the symlink to the Data Folder and keep the DB folder on the local machine
